Dear Parishioner, This Sunday is Pentecost Sunday. We recall how after Jesus ascended into Heaven, his disciples were alone and confused. They were not quite sure what they should do or indeed what it meant to be a disciple of Jesus. They needed the Holy Spirit to enlighten them.
