Dear Parishioner, This weekend we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi-The Body of Christ. After our vigil Mass this Saturday evening, there will be a procession to the grotto followed by benediction after which we will return to our Church for prayers. It is a very special occasion of veneration and thanksgiving. All children who recently received their 1st Holy Communion and who were confirmed are invited to participate. Corpus Christi is the annual feast and an occasion when we celebrate the treasure that is ours in the Eucharist. Every Mass is a memorial of Christ's sacrifice and of his gift of himself in Holy Communion - the bread of life. On Holy Thursday at the Last Supper Jesus commanded his apostles "do this in memory of Me! As he gave them "the bread of life" and the sacrifice he wished to be commemorated. From the 14<sup>th</sup> century, the feast day of Corpus Christi was celebrated with processions, prayers and benediction. We will continue the beautiful tradition this Saturday evening.

As announced last weekend a 2<sup>nd</sup> collection will be taken up as part of our national preparation for the 9<sup>th</sup> World Meeting of Families which will be held in Ireland in 2018. It is expected to attract thousands of Catholic families from around the globe with the opportunity and the challenge to renew, support and strengthen Irish families in their commitment to their faith.
